

# Connecting to AirRowdy - Windows XP

Instructions for connecting to AirRowdy, the UTSA wireless network, for Windows XP laptops. This document is intended for UTSA guests. Similar documents are available for UTSA students and faculty/staff members.

## Selecting the Wireless Network

1. On your laptop's task bar, right-click the wireless network icon and choose **View Available Wireless Networks (Figure 1)**. If the icon is not displayed, you can click the Wireless Networks icon in the Control Panel.

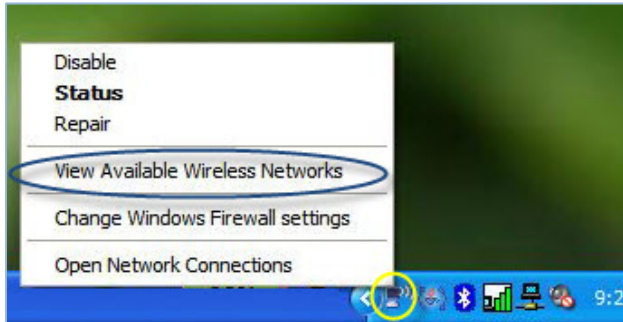
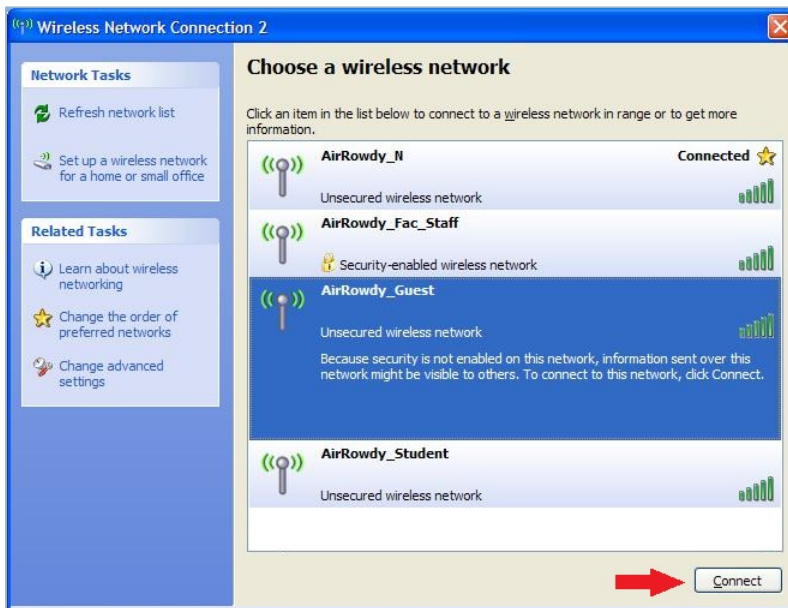

2. Click the **AirRowdy\_Guest** wireless network (SSID).
3. With AirRowdy\_Guest highlighted, click **Connect**. (Red arrow in Figure 2)

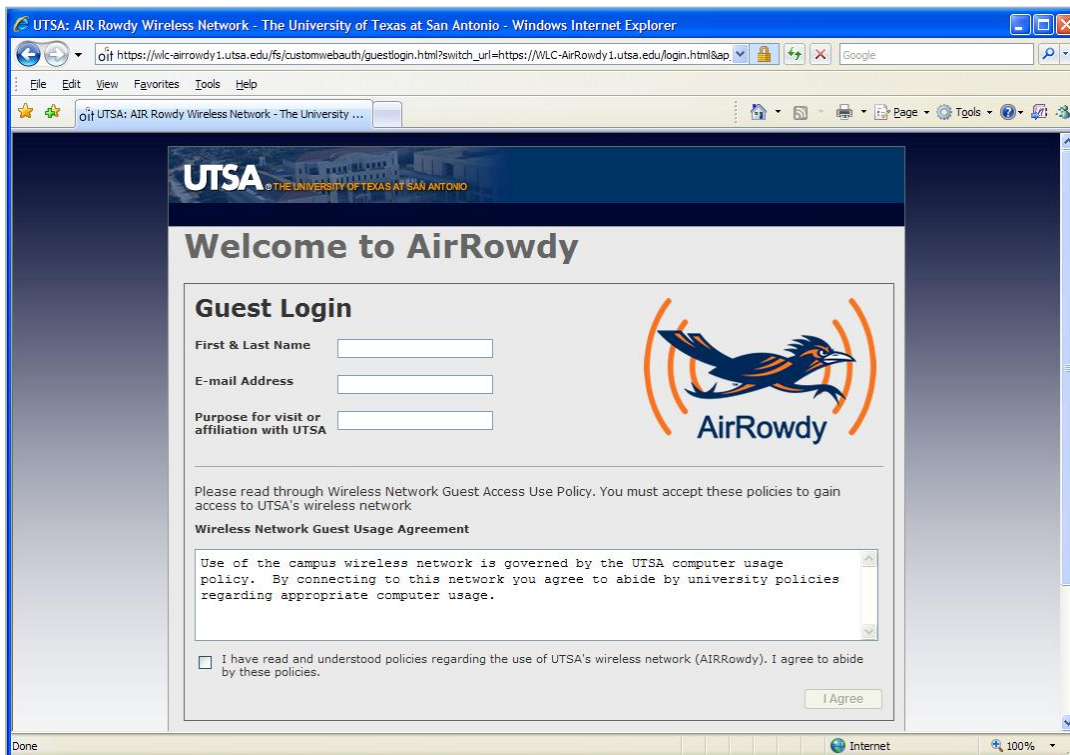
**NOTE:** If you see a message about not transmitting sensitive data over the wireless connection (Figure 3), click **Connect Anyway**.

4. Open a Web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc.) and you will be redirected to the AirRowdy login page (Figure 4).
